



## **Become a Candidate in the 2020 DERP Advisory Committee Election**

The Denver Employees Retirement Plan (DERP) is governed by a five-person Board, the members of which are appointed by the Mayor for staggered six-year terms. Additionally, there is a four-member Advisory Committee to the Retirement Board. Three members of the Advisory Committee are elected by the DERP membership for staggered three-year terms, and one member is appointed by the Career Service Board.

Mr. Robert Press's term will expire in June, 2020. Additionally, Mr. Mark Valentine's appointment to a vacated term will also expire in June, 2020.

The candidate receiving the highest number of votes will be elected to serve a three-year term. The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes, who meets the qualifications of the position, will be elected to serve until June, 2021.

**The candidates for 2020 may be either vested current City or DHHA employees, or retired DERP members.**

**The current Advisory Committee is comprised of the following individuals:**

**Frank Fresquez**, an elected retiree whose term will expire in June, 2022.

**Robert Press**, an elected retiree whose term will expire in June, 2020.

**Mark Valentine**, a current employee appointed to fill a vacated position, whose term will expire in June, 2020.

**Heather Britton**, a member of the staff of the Office of Human Resources, appointed by the Career Service Board, to a term that will expire in June, 2020.
